- Mattes presented an overview of current immigration issues.
- French presented information on Supreme Court nominee Brett Kavanaugh and also discussed Indivisible's strategy to oppose the nomination.
- Kathy Stadler discussed Indivisible's efforts to register voters at Comic Con and how HI members could volunteer.
- Cherri Shur presented tactics and strategy for supporting local candidates and issues.
- Cottingham presented the <u>Indivisible Guide</u>, a document which describes the philosophy and approach of the Indivisible movement. Groups try to influence their elected officials to better represent their constituents by staying in close contact with those officials via personal calls, letters, meetings and townhalls.
- Members were invited to attend a training immediately following the meeting led by Cathy Pfister to learn how to register voters.
