- **C.** <u>Finance Report</u>: As of our July meeting, our operational balance was \$1533.69. Since that meeting, Hillcrest Indivisible continued to build to November with both the letter-writing

campaign for "The Big Send" and postcard drive to bring out the vote. Even more, members are giving their time, efforts, and dollars into sustaining operations. After fundraising and campaign efforts, and outstanding expenses, our current operational balance is \$1044.53.
